Incomes on the Rise

Earned income has increased for 57.05% of the 149 households participating in the pilot. On average, households have increased their income by nearly \$9,700 annually. Income gains for subgroups range from \$7,557- \$12,312.

Percentage of Households Experiencing Severe Poverty

31 fewer households are experiencing severe poverty (income below 50% of poverty is \$10,980). The number of households below 100 percent of the Federal Poverty level has been reduced by 19.29%!

Program Satisfaction

A survey revealed 93% of families were extremely satisfied with the support and services they had received from the Whole Family Project.

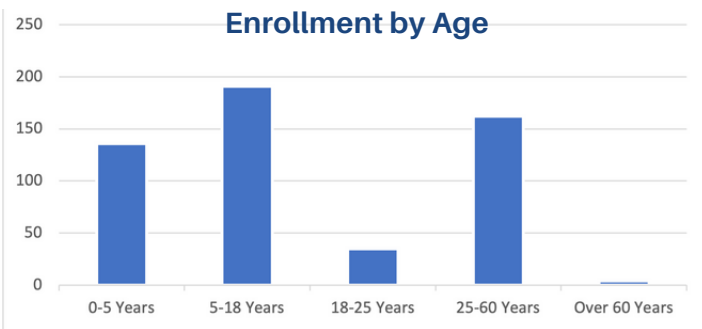


Whole Family Enrollment

Parent, Child, & Family Outcomes

- 33** Unemployed adults obtained employment (less than living wage)
- 30** Unemployed adults obtained employment (living wage or higher)
- 25** Adults obtained certification, credential, or degree
- 48** Families improved financial well-being
- 27** Children 0-5 year old improved emergent literacy skills
- 22** Children ready for kindergarten
- 75** Children 1st to 8th grade achieving at grade level
